

Arrival & Departure

Check with the coordinator from your church or school for details on departure and arrival time.

What to Bring

Please bring toiletries, a flashlight, Bible, note pad, and a pen or pencil. A signed registration form must be on file for each camper before they may participate in any camp activities. You may also want to bring sunblock, sunglasses, chap stick, and a camera. We recommend bringing spending money for our snack and souvenir store—The Bonanza Trading Co.—and for Stompin' Grounds Coffeehouse, our coffee and smoothie shop.

For Youth Camps: Please bring your own bedding and towels. Please do not bring food, pets, cigarettes, drugs, alcoholic beverages, matches, fireworks, weapons of any kind, CD/DVD/MP3 players, cell phones, pagers, electronic games and other electronic devices, clothing promoting objectionable activities, or large amounts of money or valuables.

For Adult Camps: Linens—bedding and towels—are included in your price. Please do not bring pets, cigarettes, drugs, alcoholic beverages, radios, CD/DVD players, fireworks, or t-shirts with objectionable advertising.

Special Diets

All meals are included in the price of the camping program. Those on special diets must bring their own necessary supplements. A refrigerator, microwave, and toaster are available to store and prepare special diet foods. Food from a meal served at The Mill may be set aside for a future meal. Please ask your coordinator for a menu if that would be helpful in planning.

Dress Guidelines

Guys and girls should plan to wear clothing that allows them to remain an active part of camp. If wearing shorts, please choose a longer style (like Bermuda shorts) where the length falls closer to the knee. Pants or jeans are fine as well. Please avoid any clothing that does not cover the stomach or allows underwear of any kind to show. We require all clothing to be modest and appropriate. Wolf Mountain reserves the right to ask any person to change his/her outfit if it does not comply with these standards. Please call our office if you have any questions.

Closed-toe shoes with backs are required for horseback riding and our high ropes course.

Activities

Activities offered during a week of camp may include field games, high ropes, team-building, crafts, archery, paintball, swimming, pond zip-line, and many more—at no extra cost to the camper!

Please Note

It is a good idea to mark all luggage and clothing with your name. Lost and found items not requested within thirty days will be disposed of. Requested items will be mailed at your expense. Parents are asked not to call their children during camp except in an emergency.

Participation, Release, and Medical Agreement

Waiver must be read, signed, and dated

While we make every effort to provide a safe and pleasant environment for every camper who attends Wolf Mountain, we do require that this participation agreement be read, filled out, signed, and dated by all campers (or their parent/guardian if under the age of 18) who wish to participate in activities at Wolf Mountain.

With full knowledge, I accept full responsibility for any injury or accident that may occur to myself or my child while participating in Wolf Mountain activities. I give permission for my child to participate in activities that occur at Wolf Mountain. These activities may include, but are not limited to, swimming in the pool, canoeing, high ropes course, archery, riflery, paintball, horseback riding, and strenuous competition games.

Although Wolf Mountain has taken reasonable steps to provide equipment and skilled employees so yourself, your spouse, or your child can participate in activities for which he/she may not be skilled in, we do remind you that these activities are not without risk. Certain risks cannot be eliminated due to our camp's rural setting and without destroying the unique character of those activities. The same elements that contribute to the character of these activities can be cause of loss or damage to your property, accidental injury or illness or, in extreme cases, permanent trauma or death. We do not want to frighten you or reduce your enthusiasm for these activities, but we do think it is important for you to be informed and know in advance about inherent risks.

For promotional or marketing purposes, Wolf Mountain reserves the right to use any audio, video, and/or photography of guests or campers participating at Wolf Mountain facilities.

I, on behalf of myself, my children, my assigns and my estate, agree to release and hold harmless Wolf Mountain, its officers, board, agents or employees, for any and all claims for injuries, causes of action, or liability related to my child's participation in any activity occurring at Wolf Mountain. This release does not apply to intentional and/or willful acts of misconduct by Wolf Mountain or any of its officers, board, agents or employees.

By signing this document, I acknowledge that if anyone is hurt or property damaged during my or my child's participation in these activities, I and/or my child may be found by a court of law to have waived any right to maintain a lawsuit against Wolf Mountain on the basis of any claim which has been released herein. I have had sufficient opportunity to read this entire document. I have read and understood it, and agree to be bound to its terms.
